Let's work together to make this summer a safe, productive, and unforgettable experience for our children! Wishing you a happy, safe, and sunny vacation!

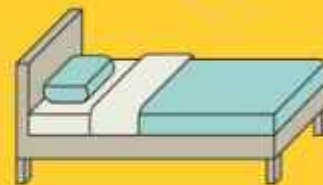
