
The values & principles setup by Late Shri R.K. Choudhary will remain the driving force for all of us for achieving success and creating best educational environment.


always believe that education is the most powerful instrument of social transformation and an important means of national development.

A kuran: Pre-Primary: Classes - Nursery, L.K.G. and U.K.G.

The philosophy behind Ankuran is, "We play as we learn and we learn as we play". Goals are set in a programme consistent with the early stages of a child's development.

The strategy used is that the letters of the alphabet are introduced phonetically, which leads to identification, recognition and reading. Various activities are planned to reinforce these concepts. Teaching is the matic and linked. Functional english is introduced.

The programme imparts linguistic, creative, numerical, social / interpersonal, motor and kinesthetic skills leading to the development of intellectual, physical, cultural, artistic and communication skills in a free and stimulating environment.

Pallawan: Primary School: Classes Ito V

These classes have an integrated academic programme devised to inculcate confidence in the child. The environment is communicative and children are motivated to express themselves. Reading is a vital part of the programme. Children are encouraged to ask questions.

Subjects Taught: English, Hindi, Mathematics, Environmental Studies, Social Studies, Computers, General Knowledge, Art, Music, Dance, Games and Heritage Study.

Unnayan: Middle School: Classes VI to VIII

The academic programme is designed to develop formal study skills and strong work habits since the demands of an external examination are more immediate. Classroom technique like pair and group work and role plays are used to develop communication skills.

Utkarsh: Secondary School: Classes IX and X

The academic programme which is decided by the education department and board of secondary education is strictly followed for the secondary classes.

Subjects Taught: English, Hindi, Sanskrit, Mathematics, Social Studies, General Science, Computer and Physical Education, Rajasthan Adhyayan.

Praffulan: Senior School: Classes XI and XII

The academic programme concentrates on providing a specialized educational experience in a nurturing and challenging scholastic environment. In addition to compulsory English, Hindi, students have to choose three elective subjects from the stream they take.

Science: Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics.

Commerce : Accounts, Business Studies, Computer Science, Mathematics and Economics. Study of Rajasthan Adhyayan is also mandatory for all.









Thus, they develop confidence and other leadership qualities like self-discipline, self-control, social awareness, positive thinking and responsibility towards the environment, community and nation. The Prefects of our School are selected by the Faculty and the House Staff. Scholarship

Scholarship is awarded by the school management for the Board Class meritorious students who are in merit list at state level including new admissions from other schools. The school management committee gives a cash reward of 11,000/- to the students of X and XII who stand in the state level Board merit list from the school.

The school management committee has declared the following scholarship for the genious students of class X (Payable for one year only) provided, they continue their study in this school till class XII. (If they leave the school after taking scholarship without completing XII class for what so ever reason,

then they have to deposit back the scholarship availed by them to the school. T.C. will be issued only after depositing back the scholarship availed by the student.)

Class X:

- -₹ 1100/- to those who achieve 80% to 85% marks.
- ₹ 2100/- to those who achieve 85.1% to 90% marks.
- Above 90% will be allowed free of cost study.
- *New admissions with above 90% marks will have to deposit admission fee.

Note:

- The students of this school, who seek admission in other schools, will not be given above mentioned scholarship.
- The scholarship will be given to the students in a special programme through cheque.

The school believes in discipline and in firmness. Slackness disobedience and disregard to rules will not be tolerated at any cost. Any work or action likely to lower the image of the school is regarded as a breach of school discipline. The school reserves the right to expel student whose diligence or the progress in studies is considered unsatisfactory or whose conduct is harmful to other students. Immorality, insubordination or contempt of authority and breaking boundaries are always sufficient reasons for immediate expulsion or rustication.

- Parents are advised not to enter the classroom to see their child or teacher during class hours without the permission of the Principal. (Kindly stick to visiting hours as announced from time to time.)
- 2. Parents are required to inform the school if there is any change in their address / telephone number and make it available to the school office.
- For security reasons leave for half day should not be asked. In emergency cases, written permission must be taken from the Principal and the class teacher should be informed.

- 4. Children, when sick, should not be sent to the school to attend classes.
- 5. Parents attention is drawn to the fact that criticism of teacher or school in the presence of the student should be scrupulously avoided because it causes the student to loose respect for their teacher with the consequent failure to learn and will retard his/her progress.
- In case of any genuine complaint, please meet the Principal at once or write a separate letter addressed to principal who will look into the matter personally.
- Any communication made by the parents / guardians should be addressed to the Principal through the class teacher.
- Parents should sign the progress report and acknowledge the same to the school within three days. If the report card is lost, a duplicate will be made only after the payment of Rs 50/-.





- 9. Parents are expected to cooperate with the school in its attempt to help student's progress by paying attention to their regularity, punctuality, discipline and by taking interest in their work. Parents without failing should check the diary every day and note the homework and other instructions given. In case of small children, they are advised to check the bags of their wards to see if any notice/invitation etc. has been issued.
- Care must be taken of all school property. If any damage is done it will be made good by the concerned student together with a fine imposed for the loss.
- 11. Parents are advised to give pocket money very judiciously to the students.
- 12. It is not advisable to bring costly articles like watches, pendrives, transistor, calculators, mobile phones and jewellery to the school. In case of any loss of valuable or other articles, the authorities will try their best to trace it but shall not undertake any responsibility for the loss.
- 13. All students are expected to join the school on the notified dates at the beginning of the term. A fine of Rs 5/- per day of absence will be imposed unless the Principal is informed before the end of assembly on the last working day.
- 14. The wards of those parents who avoid meeting the school authorities when advised to do so, may not be allowed to attend the classes.
- 15. Parents should consult the school calendar, date

- sheets and other circulars before making enquiries.
- 16. Parents should not allow their wards to ride two wheelers i.e. scooter / motorcycle. The students should use bicycles for commutation.
- The school only facilitates parking of bicycles and two wheelers outside school premises. The school does not take any responsibility of theft / loss or damage of any kind.
- 18. It is compulsory for the student to have 75% attendance in the academic year to make him/her eligible to appear in the final examination.

(B) Discipline-Rules

- The school reserves the right to take strict disciplinary action against a student if he/she-
 - (i) Violates the school rules
 - (ii) Indulges in any form of indiscipline or antisocial activity in and outside of the school.
 - (iii) Brings undesirable material or any sharp instrument or weapon to school.
 - (iv) Often arrives late to school.
 - (v) Does not stick to the prescribed uniform.
 - (vi) Misses any paper in the test / examination.
 - (vii) Misbehaves with teachers or students.
 - (viii) Mishandles, disfigures or damages any school property.
 - (ix) Acts/works in manner that is likely to lower the image of the school.

Auditorium

The School has a spacious air cooled auditorium, with a capacity to accommodate more than 800 people with all its paraphernalia to organize different indoor sports and co-curricular activities. The auditorium is used to organize different Inter House Activities, Inter School Quizzes & Indoor Sports. Luminaries from different fields of life have used this podium as a platform to address the students. Each day begins with a mesmerizing assembly that has become one of the NKPS trademark.



- 2. The school is not responsible for any loss of articles by the students.
- Habitual latecomers will be dealt with strictly. In case of emergency, parents are expected to escort the child to school.
- For fee-rules kindly refer to our fee-booklet & pay accordingly to avoid inconvenience.
- (C) Library-Rules
 - (i) All the library users must carry their library card.
 - Students are not allowed to bring their personal book to the library. However, one diary or a notebook to record articles will be allowed.
 - (iii) They must maintain silence in the library.
 - (iv) Books issued should be returned to the library in a good condition. If a book is marked / disfigured, the borrower will have to either replace the book or pay the price of the book.
 - (v) Students can get the books issued on their own cards only.
 - (vi) Books can be issued for 7 days. A fine of 1/- Rs. Per day is charged for returning book after the due date.
- (D) Rules Regarding Absence / Leave
- No leave of absence is granted except on prior written application from parents or guardians and even then for a plausible reason only.

- Every absence (due to sickness or otherwise) must be entered briefly in Non-attendance and Leave Record pages at the end of Almanac and signed by parents and guardians.
- A student returning to school after suffering from an infection or contagious disease should produce a Doctor's certificate permitting him to do so. Student suffering from the following disease must observe the prescribed period of the quarantine before returning to school.
 - (a) Chicken pox: Till complete falling of scabs.
 - (b) Cholera : Till the child is completely well.
 - (c) Measles : Two weeks after the rash disappears.
 - (d) Mumps : Until the swelling has gone, about 10-15 days.
 - (e) Whooping cough: Sixweeks
- Those who remain absent without sanctioned leave will be fined at the rate of Rs.10/- per day.
- Absence for more than three days immediately after a vacation renders the student liable to have his/her name struck off the rolls, if prior permission has not been availed.
- Leave application should always be addressed to the Principal through Class Teacher.

Enrollment and Admission

All applications for admission are to be made on prescribed form (enclosed with prospectus). The application form duly filled in must be submitted along with birth certificate on the prescribed date. No student will be admitted unless the transfer certificate and marksheet from the previous school is produced.

Nursery, L.K.G & U.K.G

For playgroup & nursery class child should be of 3+ age for Nursery, 4+ age for L.K.G and 5+ age for U.K.G as on 1st April of the year the admission is sought. Admission will be on first come first serve basis. Priority will be given to students residing near by the school. Birth certificate is strictly required.

Admission as per RTE Act

For the entry level classes Nur. & I the school completely abides by the norms defined by government i.e. RTE and keep reservation quota of 25% seats in nursery & I

Class I to XII

Child should be of 5+ age for class I, as on 1st April of the year the admission is sought. The marksheet and transfer certificate of the previous school are required from class II onwards. Admission depends on interaction with the child for class I and from class II onwards admission will depend onwrittentest followed by interview.

For the classes II onwards student will have to submit his marksheet with transfer certificate of the previous school. Admission will depend on a written test followed by an interview.

Parents / Guardians will be required to deposit the fee along with necessary certificates and photographs within 3 days of admission allowed, failing which the school will have right to cancel the provisional admission and may grant the admission to the next waiting applicant.

Transport Facility

chool has its own fleet of buses and vehicles to provide comfortable and safe transport facility to the students. Parents opting for transport facility for the children should observe the following rules:-

 School bus is a facility and not a right. Therefore this facility will only be provided if there is a vacant seat on the particular route. One sided facility will not be provided under any circumstances.

 School bus facility will be provided if there are minimum 10 students on that route.

 School buses will ply on main roads / routes and not in the interior of the colonies.

All the dues have to be cleared before any examination.





Bus facility once availed will have to be continued for six months and if anybody wants to discontinue after six months then he/she will have to inform the office at least one month in advance otherwise the request will not be entertained and one month transportation fee will be charged. No bus leaving application will be accepted after 30th Nov.

 Students availing leave has to inform one day in advance to the bus driver/office otherwise the bus will not go to the designated place the next day.





School Fee

- The fee is to be paid quarterly at the reception fee counter of the school latest by the 10th day of the month of April, July, October and January.
- 2. Late payment fee of Rs. 5/- will be charged per day after the due date up to a maximum of 30th of the month and there after the name of the student will be struck off from the school roll.
- 3. In case of re-admission a sum of Rs. 500/- will be charged along with the remaining dues.
- 4. Fee will be charged for all the 12 months.
- 5. Fee/charge once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances, whatsoever it may be.

- Bus fee will be charged for eleven months i.e. from April to March (except June).
- For board classes also i.e. VIII, X & XII the bus fee will be charged for 11 months i.e. from April to March (Except June). If anybody wants to leave the bus facility can do so by giving application by 30th Nov.
- 8. Incase fee card is lost duplicate fee card can be obtained from office on payment of Rs. 50/-.
- Please keep the fee receipts safely for your income tax purpose. Duplicate fee receipts will not be issued.



























